Child Development Centre (CDC)

Offers free services to children from birth to kindergarten. Parents and caregivers can be referred or sign-up for services themselves. The CDC can help answer questions parents and caregivers have about their child's development and provide therapeutic support to children in areas such as movement, speech/communication, social-emotional, behaviour, sleeping, eating, toileting, and sensitivities (to sound or touch). The CDC employs physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech-language therapists, developmental therapists and psychologists. The CDC also offers a Follow-Along program for children up to age 4. Parents/caregivers learn about their child's

development and milestones, learn fun ideas for activities to try at home and ask questions. Therapists support all Yukon children and travel to all Yukon communities (including Atlin, BC).
